Itinerary

4 nights/5 days from Luxor (Esna) to Aswan

Day 1

We will meet you at the airport in Luxor or at your hotel and take you to Esna (about 1 hour drive). There you will embark the dahabiya ABUNDANCE. In Esna you will visit the Chnum Temple. Then we'll set sail and start our magical journey. We'll anchor at an island in the Nile.

Day 2 - Sailing to Edfu and Wadi Shatt

In Edfu you will visit the Horus Temple, one of the best maintained temples in Egypt. Then we'll sail on to Wadi Shatt and invite you for a lovely walk through fields, plantations, villages and the desert. The ship will wait for us in Gebel el Silsila where your dinner will be served on deck.

Day 3 - Gebel es Silsila and Kom Ombo

In Gebel el Silsila you will discover ancient sandstone boulders and chapels hewn into the rock dating back to rulers of pharaonic times. Next, we will visit the double temple of Haroeris and Sobek in Kom Ombo. Your dinner will be served under the stars.

Day 4 - Sailing to Daraw

In Daraw we will visit the camel market. This is a very special experience. Then we'll stroll through the village with its colorful fruit and vegetable stalls. We'll sail on to a quiet anchorage near Aswan.

Day 5 - Disembark in Aswan

After a leisurely breakfast, Captain Mohammed and his crew will bid you farewell.

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Itinerary from Luxor to Aswan and back to Luxor
7 nights/8 days

This river cruise starts in Luxor and follows the itinerary of the 4 nights/5 days. Instead of driving back to Luxor, you remain on board and enjoy your time. On the way back, there will be no temple visits, but we stop a few times to take a refreshing swim in the Nile.

Itinerary from Aswan to Esna (Luxor)
3 nights/4 days

Day 1 - Arrival in Aswan

Embark on the dahabiya.

We set sail and start our magical journey. First you will visit the double temple of Haroeris and Sobek in Kom Ombo. In Gebel el Silsila you will discover ancient sandstone boulders and chapels hewn into the rock dating back to rulers of pharaonic times.

Your dinner will be served on deck.

Day 2 - Sailing to Wadi Shatt and Edfu

In Wadi Shatt we take a little walk through fields, plantations and villages and gain an impression of the life of the people in the farm lands. In Edfu you will visit the Horus Temple which is the best maintained temple in all of Egypt. Your dinner will be served under the starry skies on the banks of the Nile.

Day 3 - Sailing to Esna

In Esna you will visit the Chnum Tempel. Then we continue sailing and enjoy the breathtaking view of the Nile. In the night we will moor at an island in the river.

Day 4

Disembark and transfer to your hotel.
